The issue of light and its different colors was first raised in Suhrawardi's Illuminationism wisdom and then in the practical Sufism of the poles of the Kabrouyeh dynasty: Sheikh Najmuddin Kobra, Najmuddin Razi and Alaeddullah Semnani. In Mersad al-Ebad, carnality is encrypted in black, the soul of Nateqa² is encrypted in red, and the soul is confident in white. 48 In the second courtyard, the Sheikh complex is covered with red flowers, the color of which is a

symbol of love and the manifestation of God's glory or in the dome of "Allah Allah", the turquoise color is a representation of divine and celestial truth.

Rhythm is a regular, rhythmic, and time-related event because its motifs are created in chronological order. Arabesque is composed of a simultaneous combination of language and space in which the action of geometric-based circular patterns in them ascends in the ascending spirals of spiritual realization. Islamic motifs can be seen on the dome of Allah Allah, "Chinikhaneh" and the courtyard of Sheikh Safi.

Geometric patterns are generally based on numbers. In most khānaqāhs, the basis of geometry is obtained by dividing the circle into a regular square shape, which we see in the paradise and the dome of "Allah Allah", which generally have an octagonal form that symbolizes eight in heaven or eight positions. Finally, the qualitative nature of all geometric shapes tends to a single and central purpose, which, according to Burkhart, ultimately results from a circle that is a symbol of the unity of existence.
