Characters exhibiting confidence	Neal Caffrey makes a deal with the FBI to shorten his sentence. Manipulation of other characters to avoid punishment
Being the good guys	Caffrey assists the FBI in finding other white-collar criminals, which causes the audience to see him in a favorable light although he's still a criminal
Lack of deterrence	Neal Caffrey cuts a deal with the FBI instead of being punished, thus encouraging him that he can get away with his cons
