Low (LAB), Moderate (MAB), and High (HAB) Levels of Antisocial Behavior Scale Items

- 1) You are peacefully driving on the highway, listening to your favorite station on the radio. All of a sudden, another driver speeds past you and quickly cuts you off. You...
- *a. Continue listening to your song. You may feel frustrated, but you weren't hurt.
- **b. Use some profanity or give them 'the finger'.
- ***c. Try to drive dangerously closer to them, in hopes to "teach them a lesson".
- 2) It's Halloween and you hear something strange outside. When you look out the window, you see teenagers 'teepeeing' (throwing toilet paper all over) your house, trees, and lawn. You...
- **a. Yell at the kids from your window. Who do these wild animals think they are?
- *b. Decide to stay inside and simply report the crime to the police.
- ***c. Go outside and run after those kids. If their parents won't discipline them, you will.
- 3) You are on line at the grocery store. Another customer walks right in front of you. You...
- *a. Tell the customer, "I believe you accidently cut in front of me. I am also waiting on line."
- ***b. Become infuriated. You walk back to your initial spot, shoving him along the way.
- **c. Make a shallow remark to the customer. "Do you think you're slick by cutting in front of me?"
